- 2. All cups and Trophies are Perpetual Challenge Trophies and are awarded on condition that they are returned safely and undamaged to the Secretary by 1st March 2021
- 3. Any person wishing to lodge a protest having reference to any person or exhibit, shall do so in writing to the Secretary within 30 minutes of the termination of the Class to which the protest relates, and at the same time shall deposit the sum of £25.00. If on investigation by the Show Committee the protest is not sustained, the deposit shall be forfeited to the funds of the Show.
- 4. The Show or any of its officers, servants or assistants shall not be held responsible or accountable for any loss, injury, or damage that may happens from any animal or property or vehicle brought on to the Show ground, or whilst entering or leaving the same, or otherwise in connection with, or arising out of or attributable to the Show or to the Conditions and Rules prescribed by the Committee thereto.
- 5. Each exhibitor shall be solely responsible for any consequential loss, injury, or damage done to or occasioned by, or arising from any animal, including the spread of infection, or contagious disease or article exhibited or introduced to the showground by him or her, and shall indemnify the Show and its officials against all actions, proceedings, liabilities, claims, damages and expenses in relation to or arising out of his or her entry or entries to the Show.
